Jeffry "Jeff" S. Hower, 48, of Grand Island went to his Heavenly home, Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at CHI Health-St. Francis.

Celebration of life services will be held 10 AM Tuesday at the Berean Bible Church, 4116 W. Capital Ave, Grand Island. Pastor Jim Reynolds will officiate. Burial of ashes will be in the Elmwood Cemetery in St. Paul, NE.

There will be a gathering of family and friends from 5-7 PM Monday at the Berean Bible Church.

All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with the arrangements.

Jeff was born on May 24, 1970 to parents, Larry and Jayme (Johnson) Hower in Honduras.

Jeff spent much of his childhood in Puebla, Mexico while his parents served as missionaries. He came to the United States as a sophomore to attend Nebraska Christian (NC) Schools in Central City, NE. He then graduated from NC in 1988.

On December 23, 1989, Jeff married his high school sweetheart, Daurice Pizzolato. They made their home in Kearney, Central City and most recently, Grand Island.

Jeff was the Education Program Officer for the Grand Island Community Foundation. In the past, he taught English and was a principal at Grand Island Senior High. He worked at Herk's Welding in Central City, and served as the youth pastor for two local churches. Jeff and Daurice were dorm parents at NC for 8 years, and Jeff taught English and Spanish as well as coached football. For 10 years, Jeff photographed and wrote the front page news for the Central City Republican-Nonpareil. His weekly column, "I'm Just Sayin,'" was read and loved by many.

Jeff's faith has been the cornerstone of his life. At 5 years old, Jeff accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. He was a member of the Berean Bible Church where he served as an elder, a Sunday School teacher, and a member of the worship team. Jeff also worked with Iglesia El Shaddai in Hastings, and spent Sunday afternoons teaching English for the GI Literacy Council. One of Jeff's greatest loves was to read and write. He co-authored two historical books with Tom Kruger celebrating Nebraska heritage.

His memory will be cherished by his wife, Daurice; children, Alexis (Dillon) Rose and Seth Hower; parents; grandmother, Paula Johnson; siblings, Jody (Abril) Hower, Lori (Sean)

Hannon, Todd (Michelle) Hower, and Brock (Heather) Hower; mother-in-law, Grace (Jim) Nordlund; along with numerous sisters and brothers-in-law, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.

Jeff was preceded in death by his infant child, Tobi; grandparents, Everett and Hilda Hower and Vernon Johnson.
