Alfred Elmer "Al" Irmer, 84, of Hastings passed away on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 at Grand Island Veterans Affairs Medical Center.

Cremation was chosen and there will be a memorial service and burial of ashes in Nevada.

Al was born October 2, 1935 at Charleston, Nebraska, the son of Bruno J. and Irene H. (Flauss) Irmer. He grew up and received his education in York, NE. On April 5, 1956 he entered the United States Army serving during the Cold War. His duties included patrolling the then incomplete Berlin Wall. He was honorably discharged February 4, 1958.

On March 5, 1960, Alfred married Edith Eileen Lepper in Chico, CA. They made their home in South Lake Tahoe, CA. Al was in gaming for over thirty years, including employment as a pit boss at Harvey Wagon Wheel Resort and Casino and Stateline Casino in Nevada.
