Alice Robinson Elstermeier, 79 of Grand Island passed on Wednesday, December 30, 2020 at Bryan Medical Center in Lincoln.

Celebration of Life Service will be 1 PM Friday, January 8th at Trinity Lutheran Church in Wolbach. Reverends Glenda Pearson and Steven Peeler will officiate. Livestreaming will be available at Trinity Lutheran Wolbach Facebook page. The family will greet friends an hour before service time. To help protect others, facemasks are required. Alice was born on July 22, 1941 in Central City the daughter of Donald and Alva (Sims) Randall. She was raised on a farm south of Fullerton. She attended the Scudder School District #33 in Merrick County and graduated from Fullerton High School class of 1959.

In December 1967 she was united in marriage to Eugene A. Robinson in Belgrade. This union was blessed with 4 children, Ann, Will, Obie and Dean. They lived their married life on the farm west of Belgrade. Alice moved to Cedar Rapids in 1990 and Grand Island in 1994.

Alice graduated from the Platte Community College LPN Program in 1984. She retired from the American Red Cross Donor Services after 13 ½ years of service.

She was united in marriage to Norman Elstermeier in November 2012. She is

a member of Messiah Lutheran Church, the Messiah Evangelical Lutheran Church Women and Church Women United.
