



## Alvin Martin Glover

July 15, 1930 - February 22, 2014

Alvin M. Glover, 83 of Grand Island died Saturday, February 22, 2014 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Grand Island with his loving family at his side.

Services will be 10 a.m. Tuesday, February 25th at All Faiths Funeral Home. Dan Naranjo will officiate. Burial will be in the Central City Cemetery with military honors rendered by the United Veterans Honor Guard from Grand Island and the Nebraska Army National Guard.

Visitation will be from 5-8 p.m. Monday at the funeral home.

Mr. Glover was born July 15, 1930 at Wood River the son of Raymond and Mildred (Beagle) Glover.

Survivors include his wife of 66 years, Gloria; children and spouses, Dennis and Laura Glover of Phillips, Diana and Danny Larson of Funk, Deborah and Kevin Lamp of Northhome, MN, Terry and Sally Glover of Grand Island, Larry and Diane Glover of Valrico, FL and Sheri and Shaun Adams of Grand Island; 18 grandchildren and 50 great-grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by his parents; infant brother, Harold and three sisters, Darlene Horn, Doris Friend and Jean Eldracher.

Alvin was raised in an orphanage. At age 11 he went to live with a family on a farm near Chapman. Following the 7th grade he had to quit school to work on the farm. Later in life at age 70, Alvin was proud to have received his GED.

Alvin and Gloria Martin were married on January 3, 1948. Alvin served in the United States Army during the Korean War. Following the military they moved

back to the Central City area. Alvin drove truck for Behlen Manufacturing. The couple moved to Grand Island in 1962 where he worked for Grand Island Elevators. Later he started Glover Trucking having hauled for different companies. In 1983 he opened A and T Auto Repair. Alvin then went to work for Delicious Foods driving truck where he later retired.

Alvin had many enjoyments including, woodworking; stock-cars having built, owned and raced; he loved riding motorcycles having been a founding member of white spot motorcycle club; and enjoyed fishing, camping and time spent with family. He was a member of the VFW, American Legion and the Platt-Duetsche.
