Anabelle Gonzalez, 64, of Grand Island, passed away on March 5th at CHI-Health St. Francis. A Funeral Service will be held on Saturday, March 12, 2022 at 9am at the Spanish Seventh Day Adventist Church, located at 3205 Garland Ave. The Funeral Officiant will be Pastor Jorge Zelaya. Although, she traveled back and forth from El Salvador to the United States, she escaped to the United States during the Civil War in El Salvador in the 1990's. Her husband was already in Los Angeles when she began the six-month journey mostly on foot, with three children, of fleeing El Salvador to the United States. Being a devote follower of Christ, she would always find the local Seventh Day Adventist Church to take refuge, and traveled from church to church along the way. These churches provided temporary shelter and food during her travels. The family reunited in Los Angeles. About a year later the family moved to Grand Island, where they owned Libreria Bethania Bookstore for many years.

Anabelle was active in starting the Seventh Day Adventist Church for the Spanish speaking community. Her greatest joy was to serve the Lord. In her

spare time, she enjoyed cooking (everyone loved her pupusas), shopping (because she never had anything to wear), traveling (mainly to El Salvador, Guatemala, and Guanajuato, Mexico), and spending time with her dog, Bella. She was most proud of her children.
