Arlene Janice King, 90 of Lincoln, formerly of Grand Island, died Saturday October 28, 2017, at Clark Jeary Retirement Community.

Service will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, November 2nd, at United Congregational Church in Grand Island. The Reverend Lonnie Logan will officiate. Interment will be in the Grand Island City Cemetery. Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. on Wednesday at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island.
