Betty Jean Deuel, 75 of Grand Island died on Sunday, February 9, 2014 at Saint Francis Medical Center.

Mrs. Deuel was born January 28, 1939, in Loup City to Emil Lorenz Ferdinand "Lawrence" and Elva (Franklin) Otte.

Betty grew up on a farm near Litchfield where she graduated from High School in 1956 as valedictorian. She continued her education at Kearney State Teachers College. She taught at Bloody Run School, District 39, a one room school house in Sherman County.

On August 27, 1961, Betty married James William Deuel at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Ravenna. Following their marriage they made their home in Grand Island, where Betty was a substitute teacher for Trinity Lutheran School. She worked for Natural Food Products and General Nutrition Center.

Betty was an active member in the Republican National Committee, Betty Bunch, Abundant Life Christian Center, and Destiny Church, where she was in the church prayer group.

Survivors include her husband, James Deuel of Grand Island; son and daughter-in-law, Patrick and Edith of Kearney, step-grandchildren, Charlotte
