Betty Jo (Guthmann) Kruse, 83, of Grand Island passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 24, 2025.

Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 a.m. Friday, January 2nd at Resurrection Catholic Church. Burial will follow at Grand Island City Cemetery. There is a visitation at the church on Thursday, from 5-7 p.m. with a Rosary at 7:00. Memorials are suggested to the family to be designated later. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Betty was born in Grand Island on September 23, 1942, the daughter of Joseph and Wilma (Warner) Guthmann. She grew up in Grand Island, graduating from Central Catholic High School in 1960. Betty attended Kearney State College, earning bachelor's degrees in Home Economics and Art. She was a founding member of Chi Omega sorority while at Kearney State. Betty went on to teach both Home Economics and Art. After the girls had grown, she spent almost 30 years teaching preschool, first at Grace Lutheran and then at Peace Lutheran Preschool. She also occasionally substituted for Grand Island Public Schools. She found her true calling teaching as she loved children.

She was married to Gary Kruse from 1968 to 1986, and together they raised three daughters.

Betty enjoyed doing so many things. Her creative, artistic side was evident in the time spent with her beloved grandchildren as they crafted, baked, had tea parties, and played together. Betty loved to cross stitch, crochet, and knit, making many treasured pieces for family and friends. She also knitted prayer shawls for children and anyone in need. She was an avid reader, always with a book nearby and enjoyed traveling.

Those who cherish her memory include her daughters and their families, Amy (Robert) Almquist and their children, Dylan, Kara, Evan, and Payden; Jennifer (Cameron) McCarthy and their children, Thomas, Natalya, and Jacoby; and Michelle (Eric) Heilig and their children, Charlotte and Ethan.

She is also survived by three brothers, Jim (Nancy) Guthmann, Dick (Sharon) Guthmann, and John (Lanette) Guthmann.
