Beverly "Bev" Bernice Toben, 84, of Doniphan, passed away on Wednesday, November 6, 2024.

Service and celebration of Bev's life will be held at 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Doniphan. Burial will follow at Cedarview Cemetery. A visitation will be held on Sunday at All Faiths Funeral Home from 3-5 p.m. Bev was born September 13, 1940, in Grand Island, the daughter of Walter and Erna (Stueven) Boltz. She graduated from Doniphan High School with the class of 1959. Bev was raised and confirmed in the Lutheran faith and a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church.

On December 3, 1961, Bev married Wendell L. Toben. They made their home on the farm southwest of Doniphan. She was a busy farm wife, mother and homemaker, whether it was raising chickens or helping her four children with 4-H.
