“Bob” Robert L. Lilienthal, 78 of Grand Island died Friday, March 10, 2017. Services will be 10:30 a.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. Military honors will be rendered by the US Navy and United Veterans Honor Guard.

Visitation will be an hour before service time. Cremation will follow the service with burial of ashes at a later date in the Cedarview Cemetery near Doniphan. Bob was born August 6, 1938 on a family farm east of Grand Island the son of Harry and Wilma (Hurley) Lilienthal.
