Bonnie Mae Hudnall, 93, of rural Chapman, passed away on Thursday, October 24, 2024 at Grand Island Regional Medical Center.

She was quite a seamstress and did a lot of sewing for her children over the years. Knitting was a hobby she also enjoyed and was quite a talented artist.

Warren and Bonnie loved to dance together and enjoyed traveling with their friends.

Family was a very important part of her life, and she dearly loved all of her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
