Calvin Raymond Glinsmann, 73, of Cairo passed away on Tuesday, November 30, 2021.

Service and celebration of Calvin's life will be held at All Faiths Funeral Home on Tuesday, December 7th, at 10:00 a.m. Burial will follow in Evergreen Cemetery at Loup City with military honors provided by United States Army and St. Paul American Legion Honor Guard.
