Carol Rowell, 75 of Central City, longtime resident of Grand Island, passed away Tuesday, November 30, 2021 after a long battle with Parkinson's. Carol worked for the Ordinance Plant 1966-1970, a teacher's aide at Newell Elementary 1977-1979, office manager for Pediatric Associates 1979-1991, Chief Automotive 1991-1996, Toukon Management 1997-2006. She also worked as a seasonal receptionist for H&R Block for many years before her health forced her to retire. Carol loved giving back to her community. She was a volunteer for the Harvest of Harmony Parade serving as a Chair for the Queen Committee. Other involvements included past President of the Diplomats, board of directors for Central Nebraska Federal Credit Union and a member of Immanuel Baptist Church. Her other passions included gardening and her growing family.

Following their son's tragic passing in 1993 she and Jim became active with

MADD, Mothers Against Drunk Driving.
