Carole R. Stutzman, 64, of Grand Island, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on February 8, 2026, at CHI Health St. Francis. A Funeral Service will be held on Friday, February 13th at 10:30 am at Third City Christian Church, with burial immediately following the service at the Wiegert Cemetery. Visitation will be on Thursday, February 12th, from 5-7 pm at All Faiths Funeral Home.
