Carroll Henry Wolf, age 95, of Grand Island formerly of Texas, passed away on Thursday, September 25, 2025 at CHI Health St. Francis.

A funeral service with military honors will be held on Thursday October 2nd at 2pm at All Faiths Funeral Home with Father Don Buhrman officiating. The service will be livestreamed on the funeral home website. Visitation will be held from 1pm-2pm with rosary starting at 1pm. Carroll was born on July 19, 1930 in Detroit Lakes, MN to Adam and Hildegard (Vorderbrueggen) Wolf. He grew up in Minnesota and Iowa and graduated from Fort Dodge Senior High in 1948.

In 1948, Carroll enlisted in the United States Air Force reserves and would later be drafted into the Air Force. On September 27, 1949 he was united in marriage to Delores Marguerite DeLanoit. The couple had a strong partnership and dedication to their family. Delores had to be independent as she cared for the children and home while he was serving overseas, however they approached life as a team to ensuring a firm foundation for a strong family unit. His service and dedication to his country spanned over 24 years,

achieving the rank of Senior Master Sergeant. Carroll was honorably discharged from the Air Force, retiring in 1971.

After leaving the Air Force, Carroll owned and operated Bellevue Marine in Bellevue, Nebraska. He then worked for the City of Bellevue Waste Water Treatment Department for over 20 years. After his retirement, the couple traveled throughout the US and Canada in their motorhome.

Carroll loved being outdoors and that led him to sell and race snowmobiles. Spending time with his family boating, camping and taking vacations was very important to him. The family even took a trip camping across Europe. During his time in the military, he had the opportunity to visit over 60 countries. He loved everything mechanical and started the first automotive hobby shop at Offutt, and this spread to other Air Force bases. He enjoyed riding his motorcycle and being part of the motorcycle groups.

Those left to cherish his memory include children, Dennis (Mary) Wolf of Calhan, CO, Rita (Bob) Hays of Grand Island, Stan (Patty) Wolf of Roanoke, TX, Becky (Steve) Cox of Papillion, NE, Tess (Jeff) Parriott of Omaha, and Laura (Dave) Clements of Omaha; 21 grandchildren; 33 great grandchildren; 1 great great granddaughter; brother, Gerald (Nancy) Wolf of Lincoln and his beloved dog, Bo.

Carroll was preceded in death by his wife of 64 years, Delores; parents; daughter, Michelle (Al) Hutchison; grandsons, Dominic Wolf and Adam Hays and brother, Marvin Wolf.
