Charlene Joyce Hiegel, age 79, passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, April 5, 2020.

Due to COVID-19, a private family memorial service will be held on Friday, April 10th at 2:00 p.m. at All Faith's Funeral Home, in accordance with and pending all current regulations. Charlene was born on January 19, 1941 in Palmer, NE to Alfred and Evangeline (Schwarz) Meyer. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.
