Charles D. Witcher, aged 89, passed away on December 4, 2024, in Grand Island, NE. Born on June 17, 1935, Charles was known for his kindness, generosity, creativity, and loving nature.

Charles graduated from Kearney High School and continued his education at Kearney State Teachers College. He proudly served in the United States Army from February 4, 1958, to February 3, 1964.
