Clinton R. "Clint" Harry, 65, of Grand Island passed away Sunday, February 18, 2018 of congestive heart failure. The place of death was CHI Health St. Francis Hospital in Grand Island.

Funeral services and celebration of Clint's life are Thursday, February 22, at 10:30 a.m. at All Faiths Funeral Home. Burial will be at the Chapman Cemetery. Visitation is Wednesday, from 5-7 p.m. at the funeral home.

Originally from Chapman, Clint was born on February 17, 1953. He attended Northwest High School and later earned a degree from the Grand Island School of Business. He was also baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. As a young boy, Clint loved spending time at the Third City sale barn with his dad. Throughout his life, Clint was best known for his love affair with cars.

Before losing his eyesight, he worked as a sales rep for Thompson Auto Parts in Grand Island and was actively involved in drag racing. Not to be held back by his disability, Clint turned his attention to restoring classic cars. His favorites were 1960's muscle cars. He thoroughly enjoyed spending time in his garage and was always willing to share his knowledge and help others. His skills and abilities are perhaps best demonstrated by the many awards his cars and trucks won at local car shows.

His other pastimes included trivia and staying abreast of current events. He was also an avid fan of basketball and Nebraska football.

Clint was beloved by a large network of family and friends and he held a special place in the hearts of all who knew him. He truly cared about everyone

and always found time to stay in touch, whether it be talking about daily lives, cars, sports, or news of the day. Clint's home also served as the social epicenter of friends and family. He hosted a popular Friday morning coffee club for friends and rarely a day went by without some type of impromptu gathering at his home. He also took great pleasure spending time with his great nieces and nephews. It is the loss of these kinships many will miss the most.
