Dale D. Hoagland, age 89, of Grand Island, passed away on Friday, August 22, 2025 at the Veteran Affairs Medical Center in Grand Island.

Dale was born on April 22, 1936 in Edgar, NE to Marion and Theodora (Onken) Hoagland. He lived in Edgar until the age of 8 when the family moved to Harvard. Dale graduated from Harvard High School in 1953.

Dale was drafted into the United States Army and served from July 8, 1959 until he was honorably discharged on June 26, 1961.

After Dale's discharge from the Army the couple lived in Hastings for 6 years. In 1967, they moved to Wray, CO and then in 1974 they moved to Grand Island.

Dale was employed with Morrison Enterprises for 53 years as a farm manager. He retired in 2010 at the age of 74. Dale never fully retired from his passion of farming and continued helping his son, Kevin.

Dale was a member of First Faith United Methodist Church for 51 years. His faith was a vital part of who he was and how he lived his life. Dale was a member of the American Legion. He enjoyed gardening, working in the yard and around the house and was an avid Husker football and volleyball fan.
