Dale D. Miller, 86 of Grand Island died Sunday, January 24, 2016 at CHI Health St. Francis.

Services will be 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. Burial will be in the Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery. Military honors will be rendered by the Navy and United Veterans Honor Guard.

Visitation will be an hour before service.

Mr. Miller was born November 22, 1929 on a farm near Ord in Valley County. He is the son of Beryl and Ruth (Larkin) Miller.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Charlotte; son, Danny and his parents.

Survivors are his daughter, Deedee Miller of El Mirage, Arizona; brother, Donald (Catherine) Miller of Wood River, sister, Diane Coble of Lincoln and nephews and nieces, Leroy Miller, Allan Miller, Heather Refshauge and Sarah Caldararo; sister-in-law, Dorothy Hunt and brother-in-law, George Smith.

Dale was raised on a farm in Valley County until age 10, moving to Rock County, Loup County and Merrick County. He graduated from Central City

High School, class of 1947. He served in the U.S. Navy from November 7, 1950 to August 16, 1954. On July 3, 1953 he married Charlotte Smith in Wilmington, Maine. They lived in Boston and then Key West, Florida before moving to Central City in 1954. In 1956 they made Grand Island their home. He was employed by Rainbow Bakery for 26 years. He has been a member of the Grand Island Veterans Home since 2007.

He enjoyed fishing, feeding the ducks and loved dogs. Most of all he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and loved reading scripture. He and his wife were members of the Berean Bible Church.
