Dana Krueger, 57, of Valentine passed away on Thursday, December 31, 2020.

A private family service will be held at 2pm on Saturday, January 9, 2021. Services will be at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island with Dan Naranjo officiating. Dana's service will be available via a live stream broadcast through All Faiths Funeral Home facebook page.

Memorials are suggested to the Valentine Volunteer Fire Department.

Dana was born on January 15, 1963 in Grand Island, NE son of Kay and Vera (Muhs) Krueger. He attended Grand Island Public Schools and graduated from Grand Island Senior High in 1981. Dana earned his Bachelor Degree in Wildlife Range Management and Aquatics from the University of Idaho. He interned with the U.S. Forest Service in Montana then moved to Mississippi where he started a career in the commercial catfish industry where he raised and managed catfish. In 2000, Dana welcomed an opportunity to return to Nebraska. He accepted a position with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission in their Fisheries Division – Calamus Hatchery, Burwell, NE. From there he became the Manager of the Valentine State Fish Hatchery in Valentine, NE. Currently, Dana was employed as the Natural Resource Supervisor for the Middle Niobrara Natural Resource District in Valentine. Dana was a lifetime member of the NRA and Valentine Volunteer Fire Department. He was an avid outdoorsman and always ready for an adventure. Dana loved to hunt and fish; especially with friends and family. He recently

fulfilled his dream of having his home overlook a canyon where he could watch nature right out his front door. He also accepted the challenges that come with building and took a lot of pride in finishing his own home. Dana was an Uncle his nephews and nieces looked up to and admired. He enjoyed sharing his love of the outdoors with them anytime he could.

Anyone who knew Dana appreciated his fun loving sense of humor and respected his work ethic.

Dana is survived by his mother, Vera Krueger of Grand Island; siblings, Doug (Cami) Krueger of Aurora, Dawn (Marvin) Lutz of St. Libory; special friend, Cindy Schroeder of Valentine; numerous nephews, nieces, aunts and uncles and many friends.

Dana was preceded in death by his father, Kay Krueger and his beloved dog, Crockett.
