Daniel J. Luton, 61, of Grand Island passed away Tuesday, April 14th. A memorial service is being held on Saturday, July 25th at 10:30 am at All Faiths Funeral Home. Fr. Richard Piontkowski will officiate. CDC guidelines and social distancing will be followed and face masks will be required.

Dan was born on July 21, 1958 in Columbus, NE., to Daniel M. and Marcella (Richter) Luton, the seventh of ten children. The family moved to Grand Island in 1966. Dan was in the Army, and served at Fort Carson, where he assisted in the cleanup after the Big Thompson Flood.

On June 19, 1992, he was united in marriage to Mary (Reed) Huebner. The couple made their home here in Grand Island. Dan had many jobs after leaving the army in 1979, from bus driver at Good Life to hanging drywall for E&K. He made his career as a welder at PMI, Chief and Standard Iron for over 30 years. He was also known to many as Dan the hardware man, from his years at Ace Hardware.

He was baptized into the Catholic faith at Saint Anthony's in Columbus. Some of his favorite activities include playing golf and watching Husker football. Dan was known for being a handyman that enjoyed working in his yard, and his love of a "good" joke.
