Darlene Lillian Ledgerwood, 94, of Grand Island passed away on Wednesday, September 30, 2020.

Darlene was born September 7, 1926 in Omaha, the daughter of Emil and Goldie (Fous) Hason. She received her education in Omaha, attending Omaha Tech High School. As an athlete, she was very proud of the part she played in the girl's athletics. She was always an avid sports fan. Darlene married the love of her life, Frederick Ledgerwood, on December 12, 1943 when she was seventeen, prior to Fred shipping overseas for WWII.

When Fred returned stateside, Darlene joined him in Tampa, FL, before the couple relocated to Omaha. In 1952, they moved to Grand Island. As a certified bowling instructor, Darlene worked at the former Mavis Bowl. She took pride in the number of people she had taught to bowl. She was active in the bowling circle and bowled until she was physically unable to do so. For several years Darlene also worked as a teller for First National Bank in Grand Island.
