David Aaron Prescott, 74, of Grand Island passed away Friday, December 13, 2019 at Country House Residence.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 18 at All Faiths Funeral Home, Grand Island. Military honors will be provided by the U.S. Air Force and United Veterans Honor Guards. Visitation will be an hour prior to service time.

Burial will be at 3:00 p.m. Wednesday at the Broken Bow Cemetery followed by a celebration of life reception at Broken Bow Evangelical Free Church.

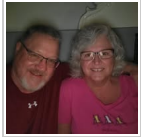
