Delores "Dee" Eberl, 85, of Grand Island went to her heavenly home on Friday, February 2, 2018, surrounded by family.

Memorial service and celebration of Dee's life will be on her birthday, Monday, February 5th, at 11:00 a.m. at the Evangelical Free Church. A gathering of friends and family will be from 3-6 p.m. Sunday at All Faiths Funeral Home.

Dee was born February 5, 1932 in Superior, NE, the daughter of Joseph and Amy (Thompson) LeMay. Her mother died when she was twelve, and she was the eldest of five children. She graduated from Kimball County High School in 1950. On October 28, 1950 Dee married Richard "Dick" Eberl in Kimball, NE. They raised their children on St. Paul Road in Grand Island, where Dee still resided at the time of her death.

Dee was devoted to her family, but she also worked outside the home, mostly as a switchboard operator. She retired from the VA Medical Center in 1997.

Dee was a volunteer with Saint Francis Medical Center, Community Concert Association, The Grand Theater and White Cross Ladies at E-Free Church.

She enjoyed several bible study groups which enriched her love for her Lord, watching her grandchildren in a variety of sporting and dance events, playing cards and eating with family and friends, attending ALL of the local plays and musicals, and the joys and frustrations of her iPad and "the facebook". Dee also enjoyed traveling, both in Europe and the States. Last April she traveled to Florida with her five daughters where she enjoyed beach strolls and a hot air balloon ride, which was crossed off her bucket list. She was headed to

Arizona on her 86th birthday, but the Lord had other plans.
