Dennis was born March 24, 1955 in Grand Island the son of Donald and Rosanna Marie (Obermeier) Stoltenberg. He was raised and has lived on the family farm NW of Grand Island his entire life. Dennis graduated from Northwest High School class of 1973. On October 4, 1975 he was united in marriage to Kristie Payton at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Grand Island. Dennis farmed and was a cattle feeder. He started working at Agricultural Services while in high school which continued until his retirement in December 2021. He was a member of Calvary Lutheran Church, Saddle Club, Platt Duetsche, Pheasants Forever and volunteered for all the Hall County Hero Flights. He is a lifetime member of Hall County 4-H and continued with kids and grandkids.

His enjoyments included Husker athletics especially Husker Volleyball, a huge fan of the Kansas City Royals and Chicago Bears. He was a dedicated blood donor to the American Red Cross donating 26 gallons of blood over his

lifetime. In retirement he was looking forward to spending more time with his kids and grandkids, attending all of their activities especially going to get “gas” aka taking them to Dairy Queen. Dennis was the most friendly, happy outgoing individual you would come across and never met a stranger. He will be truly missed by everyone that knows him.
