Devlin Richard Kenney, 37, of Grand Island died on Tuesday, August 4, 2020.

Service and celebration of Devlin's life will be 1:00 pm Saturday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. There will be a time of visitation from 12:00 noon until the time of the service.

Devlin was born in Kearney on July 7, 1983, the son of James and Diane (Taubenheim) Kenney. The family moved from Amherst to Grand Island and Devlin attended Grand Island schools.

On July 25, 2005, he married the mother of his daughters, Karla Rosete. Devlin had several places of employment, most recently he worked at JBS.

As a young man, Devlin was confirmed at Peace Lutheran Church. He would talk about his faith and discuss his views on various Bible verses without hesitation.
