Donald "Don" E. Olson, 86, of Grand Island passed away peacefully, at his home, surrounded by his family on Wednesday, January 31, 2024.

He enjoyed watching Husker football and volleyball and was a member of Messiah Lutheran Church. His somber face and love for his family will be missed.

Don is survived by his wife, Jeanie Olson of Grand Island; son Todd Olson of Grand Island; grandsons, Zach Olson of Grand Island and Jake Olson of
