Donald Dean "Don" Rembolt, 69, passed peacefully Thursday, March 30, 2017 at the family farm in Merrick County.

To honor his wishes cremation has taken place and a private burial of the ashes and celebration of life will be at a later date.

Don was born July 6, 1947, to Marvin and Emma (Wagner) Rembolt in Palmer, NE. He attended rural Dist. 32 one room grade school K-8th and graduated from Grand Island Northwest, class of 1965.

Don enlisted in the United States Airforce in 1966 and was honorably discharged, with the rank of Sergeant, in 1972. While in the service he trained as a jet mechanic. Following his time in the service Don returned to the family farm where he became the fourth generation to farm this land. He retired in 2011.

Always one to take on new skills, he learned how to grow Giant Pumpkins. He only planted one or two plants and always said with a smile, "I'm still farming, just with one plant." The biggest pumpkin came close to 1400 lbs. He was a good farmer.

Throughout his life Don enjoyed many hobbies, hunting, fishing, racing, bowling, reading, searching the internet and just sharing a beer with good friends. He could tell a good story but would always be there to listen or help with whatever project needed help. He was one of a kind.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a niece, Jennifer Betts.

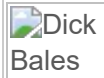
