Doyle William Muhs, 81, of Grand Island passed away on Thursday, June 17, 2021.

There will be a private memorial service held at All Faiths Funeral Home. Mr. Muhs was committed to spending his last days on the land where he was born, raised and lived his entire life. He attended Lockwood Elementary School and graduated from Grand Island Senior High, class of 1958. He was inducted into the United States Army September 6, 1963 and was honorably discharged August 24, 1965. In October 1963, a month after his induction, he married Carol Roberts.

Following his service, Doyle returned to the farm. He felt he was entrusted with God's land and faithfully fulfilled that mission for 79 years.

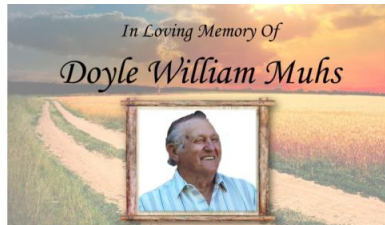
