



## Eugene Wesley Anderson

Eugene Wesley Anderson, 74, of Grand Island, Nebraska, passed away on June 6, 2025 at the CHI Health St. Francis Hospital in Grand Island, Nebraska following an illness. Visitation will be held on Saturday, June 21 from 1 to 3 p.m at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island, Nebraska.

Eugene was born on August 14, 1950, in Holdrege, Nebraska, to Wesley and Dorothy (Gitt) Anderson. He grew up in Holdrege and was the second of four children in the family. He graduated from Holdrege High School in 1968 and attended the University of Nebraska Lincoln.
