



## Evalyn M. Sorahan

May 17, 1920 - January 19, 2017

Evalyn M. Sorahan, 96, of Grand Island passed away with her family by her side on Thursday, Jan. 19, 2017.

Evalyn, who was affectionately known as “Babe” by all who knew and loved her, was born on May 17, 1920 to Richard and Freda (Peterson) Erdbruger of Grand Island, Nebraska. Along with her two brothers and sister, she grew up on a small acreage near Grand Island and often shared fond memories of her childhood.

She attended Stolley Park School and graduated from Grand Island Senior High in 1937. On November 1, 1939, Evalyn married Samuel J. Sorahan, who died in service to our country at Iwo Jima on February, 20, 1945. Evalyn then worked part-time and raised their son, Samuel, on her own until she was united in marriage to Michael A. Sorahan on September 17, 1946. In 1947, they built their current family home on Park Drive and were blessed with four more children.

Evalyn was a true “homemaker” who created a warm, loving welcome for all. She loved to cook and bake and took great pleasure in spoiling her friends and family with treats. Her chocolate chip and sugar cookies were especially loved by her family and were often the source of family battles about ownership. Later in life, she shared her exceptional culinary skills with many

students as a cook at Barr Junior High. Evalyn also loved spending time in her yard and garden, which flourished from her attentions.

Family was very important to Evalyn. Her children and grandchildren knew she was always there, ready to listen and help in what ever way she could. Some of Evalyn's happiest moments were when she was preparing and hosting family get-togethers for her children and grandchildren. Family will always remember Evalyn's gentle strength, with seldom a critical word for others.
