



## Evelyn Alice Ewers

October 12, 1917 - October 31, 2014

Evelyn A. Ewers, 97, of Omaha, formerly of Grand Island, died Friday, October 31, 2014 at Josie Harper Hospice House in Omaha, Nebraska. Services will be Saturday at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Grand Island. The Reverend Edgar Schambach Jr. will officiate with a private interment at Grand Island Cemetery.

Visitation will start at 9:30 a.m. at the church preceding the funeral. All Faiths Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

Evelyn was born August 12, 1917 in Grand Island to Claude and Linda (Hansen) Powell. She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert, in October 2000.

Survivors include daughter Patricia Peterson and husband Neil of Minneapolis, MN; daughter Carol Bowden of Omaha, NE; and son Robert Ewers and wife Judy of Barrington, Illinois.

Also surviving are 10 grandchildren and their spouses: Kathryn, Anne, Sarah, Jennifer, Thomas, Mary, Tonya, Robert, Emily and Amy; 14 great grandchildren: Phillip, Linda, Carolyn, Benjamin, William, Jacob, Kate, Adelaide, Evelyn, Katherine, Embry, Madelyn, Lauren and Brock; and one great-great granddaughter, Norah Evelyn.

Evelyn graduated from Grand Island High School in 1935 and married Robert Ewers on August 6, 1940. During her years in Grand Island, she worked for many doctors, most notably E. A. Brugh, M.D. as his office manager.

Evelyn was a life-long resident of Grand Island with the exception of her last

year in Omaha and 17 years spent in Sacramento, CA. She was active in the YWCA, Liederkrantz, Platt Duetsche, Saddle Club, several bridge clubs, the Naomi church circle at St. Paul's Lutheran, and the Nebraska Angel Club. She volunteered for St. Francis Medical Center and several women's organizations.

She was a special Mom and Nana to her children and grandchildren. When she became a great grandmother, she was called Nana the Great or "NTG". She was a generous, funny, and energetic perpetual redhead who never saw herself as old. Her passing will leave a hole in many hearts.
