Evelyn Pearl (Woodward) Glause, 94, of Grand Island, NE went to be with her Lord and Savior on March 31, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Senior Residence in Wood River, NE.

The service celebrating her life will be Saturday morning, April 4 at 10:00 A.M. at All Faiths Funeral Home. Daniel Naranjo will officiate. Burial will be at the Grand Island Cemetery with a gathering for family and friends following at her home.

Those left in her immediate family to cherish her memory include her daughter and son-in-law, Hollie Ann (Glause) Seamster and husband Elgie Seamster. They grew up in Archer, NE in the home of their paternal grandparents, Charles H. Woodward and their grandmother, Florence, after the death of their mother when they were nearly one year old. Pearl had wonderful memories of her

loving grandparents and her “aunties” who helped raise her and of her home in Archer. The one great sadness that she carried all of her life was not getting to know her mother. She married Cecil in 1939 and became his helpmate for life farming near Archer and Central City. After retiring from farming, Pearl and Cecil moved to El Paso, TX for 10 years to be near their daughter and grandsons. When the grandchildren went away to college, Pearl and Cecil moved back to Grand Island to be in their beloved Nebraska.

Pearl’s family and faith were the center of her life. She was a marvelous cook and baker, loving gardening and sharing all the goodies with her family. In addition, she was an excellent seamstress and enjoyed knitting and crocheting. China painting and doing ceramics with friends also was a joy of hers, and she made lovely gifts for those she loved. She loved nature, especially birds and other wild creatures that she encountered during her country walks. Lastly she loved music and imparted that love to her daughter. She sang in her church choir for many years and served as spiritual life leader for the Columbus Nebraska Methodist conference and truly walked the walk of her Christian faith, even having a prayer room in her home.
