In 1982 Faye and Gene moved to Campbell Avenue, west of Doniphan, where they enjoyed lakeside living. They also enjoyed watching their four grandsons play in the lake and go fishing.

Faye was a long-time member of the Methodist Church in Doniphan and was involved with many different groups and Bible studies until illness and age prevented her from attending. She last lived at Prairie Winds Assisted Living,

where she was able to reconnect with some old friends and was able to meet many new ones.
