Faye Lorraine Wagner, 65, of Grand Island, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, Nov. 17, 2017, following a courageous battle with cancer.

Faye Lorraine (Kumm) Wagner was born May 14, 1952, the oldest child of Vernon G. and Berneice H. (Rafert) Kumm in Holyoke, Colorado. Her family lived in Colorado, South Dakota and northeast Nebraska before settling in Grand Island where she graduated from Senior High in 1970.

Shortly after graduation, Faye was employed by Northwestern Bell as an operator where she remained until the US West restructuring of 1993. In 1994 she went to work at the Hall County Court house and took classes at Central Community College earning an Office Technology Diploma in May of 1995. In July, 1995 Faye began a 20-year career with the Social Security Administration in Grand Island, retiring due to health issues in 2015.

In 1989, at Grand Island, Faye married Thomas Conlon. He passed away in 2013.

Faye's kind, gentle, and loving spirit and hospitality were enjoyed and appreciated by all who knew her. Her interests and hobbies included gardening, birding, cooking, and traveling. In retirement she developed an avid interest in the Bible and became a member of Third City Christian Church and it was there she met and married her husband, Mikel Wagner.

Faye is remembered with love by her husband, Mikel of Grand Island; sisters,

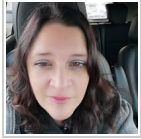
