Mr. Mierau was born June 21, 1925 in York County at Henderson to Frank and Anna (Martens) Mierau. He was born again on May 27, 1959.

Survivors are his sons and daughters-in-law, Steven and Gwen Mierau of Bolivar, MO and Mike and Judy Mierau of Grand Island; a brother, Orville Mierau of Aurora, CO and six grandchildren.
