Frederick William Fischer died on Monday, August 12, 2019.

The funeral will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, August 17th at Trinity Lutheran Church in Grand Island. Pastors Dan Myers and Adam Snoberger will officiate. Burial will be at the Phillips Cemetery.

Visitation will be from 5-7 p.m. Friday at Trinity Lutheran Church. All Faiths Funeral Home is entrusted with arrangements.

Frederick was born on a farm near Langdon, Missouri to Fredrick and Ella (Ohrt) Fischer on May 27, 1930. He was baptized at St. Peter Lutheran Church at Langdon, Missouri. He attended grade school at Phelps City and Rock Port, Missouri and Trinity Lutheran School in Grand Island. In 1944 he was confirmed in Trinity Lutheran Church in Grand Island. He attended high school in Colorado Springs, Colorado, graduating in 1948. Frederick attended Concordia Teachers College in Seward, Nebraska, graduating in 1953. On August 10, 1952, he married Louise Meyer at Trinity Lutheran Church, Ludell, Kansas.

For twenty years Frederick taught in Lutheran grade schools in Wichita, KS, Sylvan Grove, KS, Falls City, NE and North Platte, NE. He served as a District Manager for World Book Encyclopedia and as a District Representative for Aid Association for Lutherans. For 17 years he and his wife did commercial cleaning for Norwest Bank and US Bank. Frederick was also a test administrator for Insurance Testing Corporation and Thomson-Prometric.

Frederick is survived by his wife, Louise; four daughters and their husbands, Connilee and Rev. Daniel Myers of Wichita, KS, Carol and Marvin Kirchner and Janet and Tim Zuehlke of Grand Island, NE, and Janelle Fredrick of Omaha, NE; nine grandchildren and their spouses, Rachel (Adam) Orsborn, David (Jenny) Myers, Kevin Kirchner, Scott (Kathryn) Kirchner, Lisa (Eric) Rasmussen, Beth (Layne) Reed, Michael (Allison) Fredrick, Ryan Zuehlke and Amber Zuehlke (Ryan Haeg); and 13 great-grandchildren, Madelyn, Hannah,
