"Fred" Frederick William Lampe age 90, of Grand Island formerly of York, died Sunday January 1, 2017 at Wedgewood Care Center.

Funeral service will be 10:30 a.m. Friday at the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in York. Reverend Mike Neidow will officiate. Burial will be at 1 p.m. Friday at the Greenwood Cemetery in York. Military honors will be rendered by the York American Legion and U.S. Army.

Visitation will be 5 to 7 p.m. Thursday at All Faiths Funeral Home in Grand Island.

Fred was born on July 25, 1926 at Rising City, NE the son of Emil and Matte (Rathjen) Lampe. He grew up at Gresham, NE and received his education there. He entered the United States Army on March 16, 1951 serving during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged on December 15, 1952. Fred was united in marriage to Althea Steinhauer on October 18, 1953. Following their marriage they lived in York, NE.

Fred was employed by York Pack and Greenwood Cemetery. He was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church for 63 years and the American Legion Post. His true love was being in the garden. He was known in York County for his garden. Fred deeply adored his three granddaughters. There was nothing he wouldn't do for them. He loved being a grandpa.

Survivors include his wife of 63 years, Althea; daughter, Verna (John) Haberman; brother, Emil (Jan) Lampe; 3 grandchildren Laura (Will) Swett, Erica Haberman, and Maggie (Josh Price) Haberman.
