February 3, 1935 - December 5, 2014

Glen E. Hallner, 79, of Grand Island, died Friday, December 5, 2014, of complications from Parkinson's disease at Mary Lanning Hospital, with his family at his side.

A Memorial Service will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Reverend Matthew Fowler will officiate. Burial of ashes will be at Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery. Since Glen hated wearing a suit and tie, the family is requesting casual dress.

Glen was born February 3, 1935 in Ericson, NE, to Cecil and Mabel (Gray) Hallner.

Those left to cherish his memory include his wife of 48 years, Nelda; his sons, Brian Hallner of Omaha and Scott (Susana) Hallner and grandson, Scott, of Queen Creek, AZ; sister, Ruby (Tony) Usasz of Grand Island; nieces and nephews and other relatives; his special friend and co-worker, Terry Cook of Grand Island and many other friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant daughter, Cheryl.

Glen graduated from Ericson High School in 1952. He entered the United States Army in February, 1956, and served with a Special Services Unit in Heidelberg, Germany until his discharge in 1958.

Glen returned to Nebraska and was united in marriage to Nelda Handel on August 14, 1966, in Wauneta. They made their home in Grand Island. Glen was a maintenance mechanic for Missouri Valley Construction Company for nearly ten years and for New Holland for 25 years. He also worked for

Penrose Machining before retiring due to ill health. He was a member of First Faith United Methodist Church.

Glen enjoyed camping trips and took his family on many vacations. Family was an important part of his life. He could build and fix nearly anything and was always tinkering on some project. Glen willingly lent a hand to help his friends and neighbors in any way he could, and his determination got him through many tough times.
