Harold E. Vollmer, 86, of Grand Island passed away Wednesday, October 27, 2021.

Memorial service and celebration of Harold's life will be 10:30 a.m. Monday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Burial of ashes will be at Grand Island City Cemetery with military honors provided by United States Army and Grand Island Veterans' Honor Guard.

There will be a gathering of friends and family from 9:30 until the time of service.

Harold was born April 25, 1934 at rural Overton, NE, the son of Harley and Pearl (Bowden) Vollmer. He grew up in Eddyville, graduating from Eddyville High School, class of 1952.

On February 25, 1954, Harold entered the United States Army serving during the Korean War. During a leave, on November 7, 1954, Harold was united in marriage to JoAnn Muirhead. He was honorably discharged February 16, 1956.

For nearly 28 years, Harold was manager of Normandy Apartments. He later worked part-time for Hobby Lobby.

Over the years, he and JoAnn had taken numerous trips, including Mexico, Hawaii and Europe, and a couple of cruises. Another enjoyment was hunting, his favorite site being the Fort Robinson area.
