Harry E. Gregersen, 88 of Grand Island passed away on January 2, 2017 at the Grand Island Veteran's Hospital.

Celebration of his life service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Burial of ashes will be held at a later date in El Dorado, Kansas.

Harry was born on October 17, 1928 to Clarence Peter and Nadine Lovina (Hays) Gregersen at Neosho Falls, KS.

He is survived by his son, Bruce Gregersen of Grand Island; granddaughter, Stasha (Aaron) Fulton; grandson, Adam Rohling; special sister-in-law, Marietta Gann; and a multitude of friends and clients.

Mr. Gregersen was preceded in death by his wife, Phyllis; infant son, Danny Joe; daughter, Leisa Rohling; sister, Norma Maurer and his parents.

He attended grade school in Hutchinson, KS, high school in El Dorado, KS and Kansas University. Harry was active in baseball, tennis, and played his trumpet anytime and everywhere.

Harry entered the United States Marine Corps upon graduating from high school, along with three other of his close friends and was honorably discharged in 1949.

On December 24, 1950, Harry was united in marriage to Dorothy Phyllis Bruce.

Harry's father was a professional paint contractor and Harry grew up working in this business. In 1952 he accepted a position as regional manager for the

Seidlitz Paint Co. He was stationed in Denver, CO, servicing major stores and wholesalers in seven states.

In 1959, Harry entered the Life and Health Insurance business continuing until his death. His business took the family to several towns, and ended up in Grand Island in 1967.

Harry received great satisfaction in using his knowledge and expertise in helping his clients, most of which became friends as well.

These services honored him with many awards, and took he and Phyllis on many trips to places like Acapulco and Hawaii.
