Harvey A. Delarm, 81, of Phillips died March 1, 2015 at CHI Health St. Francis in Grand Island.

Mr. Delarm was born on June 14, 1933 in Scotia, Nebraska, the son of Emmett C. and Ruth (Cutler) Delarm. They lived in Scotia, NE, Missouri, and California before coming to Phillips, NE. He graduated from Phillips High School in 1952. He entered the United States Army in 1955 and served until 1957.

On July 31, 1957, Mr. Delarm married Lila England in Phillips, NE. They lived in Grand Island, NE until moving to a farm near Phillips in 1961.
