Helmuth E. Stahr, age 94, of Grand Island, passed away on Sunday, May 31, 2026, at Grand Island Regional Medical Center.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, June 8th at 10am at Trinity Lutheran Church with Pastor Adam Snoberger officiating. Helmuth was born on November 21, 1931, in Lincoln to Martin Fredrick and Henrietta (Naber) Stahr. Helmuth was baptized as an infant and confirmed on March 25, 1932 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Waco. He attended grade school at St. John's Lutheran in Waco and graduated from Waco High School in 1949. After graduation he took classes at Concordia. Helmuth enlisted in the United States Army in 1952 serving in Korea, he was honorably discharged in 1954.

On May 1, 1955, he was united in marriage to Carolynn R. Lottes. Four children were blessed into this union. Helmuth was employed with Hughes Brothers in Seward and farmed near Waco. When he moved to Grand Island, he worked for Northwest Public Service from 1958 until 1994. He became a

member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Grand Island in 1958 and was a life member of the VFW. In his spare time, Helmuth enjoyed fishing, hunting, camping and traveling.
