



Henry "Hank" Wiese

February 8, 1921 - July 1, 2014

Henry "Hank" Wiese, 93, of Grand Island died on Tuesday, July 1, at Wedgewood Care Center.

Memorial services will be 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, July 8th at All Faiths Funeral Home. Dan Naranjo will officiate. Burial of ashes will be in the Grand Island Cemetery with military honors.

Family will be greeting friends half an hour before service time.

Hank is survived by his three daughters from his first marriage, Judith (Lyle) Tibbs, Janet (Chuck) Bosselman, and Lana Lofgreen; two daughters from his second marriage, Annette (Mark) Hollister, and Julie Garcia.

He is preceded in death by his parents, and nine brothers and sisters.

Hank was born on February 8, 1921, in Grand Island to Henry and Hermine (Arp) Wiese.

He attended school at District #3 and received his high school diploma. Hank worked for farmers at a young age, as well as the Union Pacific Railroad and Nash Finch. On September 18, 1943 he enlisted in the Army and was honorably discharged with the rank of Corporal on December 9, 1944.

He returned to Grand Island and continued to work for Nash Finch, the Union Pacific Railroad and then John Claussen Construction. He went to night school for four years to learn the construction trade. John Claussen Construction made him foreman after the first year of completing night school. He worked for them for 39 years. It was during those years that he perfected his carpentry, and also earned respect from the other workers.

He married Lelia Belle Stahlnecker on November 2, 1941. They divorced on May 16, 1963. He then married Dorothy Colfak of November 27, 1965 and they divorced on September 27, 1988.

He enjoying polka and was a skilled dancer. He loved to garden, tend his lawn, and hunting.

Hank belonged to Platt Duetsche, American Legion, Eagles and the Disabled American Veterans.
