Isaias "Chino" Sanchez, 92 of Grand Island died on Thursday, April 14, 2016 at - St. John -Good Samaritan Society in Kearney.

A Memorial service will be held on Tuesday at 10:30 a.m. at All Faiths Funeral Home. Dan Naranjo will officiate. Burial of ashes will follow at Westlawn Memorial Park Cemetery. Military honors will be rendered by U.S. Army Reserve and Grand Island Veterans Honor Guard.

Chino was born on January 1, 1924 in Grand Island, son of Pedro Sr. and Juana (Torres) Sanchez.

He is survived by his sisters, Mary Ramirez of Dallas, TX, Patty (Joe) Galvan of Grand Island, and Emily Valdez of Grand Island; along with numerous nieces, nephews and extended family and friends.

Chino is preceded in death by his parents, brothers, Frank, Mike, and Pete; sisters, Rose Jones and Flora Valdez; and special friend, Norma Shada.

Chino was raised in Grand Island where he attended school. In May of 1943, Chino enlisted in the U. S. Army. He served in the artillery division in Europe

until the end of World War II. He was honorably discharged on November 5, 1946.

Following his service in the Army, Chino returned to Grand Island and worked for a time as a farm hand and as a guard in the local Prisoner of War camp. He was then employed by the Union Pacific Rail Road until his retirement.

In his younger days, Chino played baseball. He was a husker fan and loved to watch the horse races. He enjoyed a good laugh and spending time with his friends and family.
