Jack A. Hann, 92, of Grand Island, died on Sunday, January 11, 2015 at the Grand Island Veterans' Home.

A Celebration of Life service will be held 10:30 a.m. on Friday, January 16, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Reverend Bill Pavuk will officiate. Burial of ashes will take place at a later date in the Grand Island Cemetery.

To honor Jack's wishes cremation has taken place. All Faiths Funeral Home is serving the family.

Jack is survived by his children, Debra Hann of Grand Island and Douglas Hann of Columbus; sister-in-law, Joan Hann; brothers-in-law, Jack (Jeanine) Dodge and Levi (Verneal) Dodge; along with numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, extended family and friends.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Helcyon "Pat" in 2011; parents; sisters, Donna and Shirley; and brother, Jim.

Jack was born on March 6, 1922, in Grand Island to George and Margaret (Langman) Hann.

He grew up in Grand Island where he attended school. On November 25, 1942, Jack entered the United States Army, and served until April 15, 1946 during WWII.

On November 24, 1947, he was united in marriage to Helcyon "Pat" Dodge. Following their marriage the couple made their home in Grand Island, where Jack worked as a Police officer for GIPD, Deputy Sheriff for Hall County, and Dub's Sporting Goods. He opened and operated Jack's Radio and TV; later he worked airport security and maintenance.

Jack was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church and the Platt Deutsche. He enjoyed

spending his time fishing, hunting, gardening, working on the computer, and playing the harmonica. Most important of all, Jack treasured time spent with family and when he could dog sit for grand-dog, KiKi.
