Jack Hansen, 82, of Grand Island, left this life on Dec. 18, 2015 to spend eternity with his beloved Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Services will be at 11:00am Tuesday at All Faiths Funeral Home. Pastor John Hayes of Grace Baptist Church, where Jack attended, will officiate. Burial will be in the Grand Island Cemetery. the United Veteran's Honor Guard and U.S. Navy will provide military rites.

Jack was born on October 8, 1933 in Arthur, NE. He graduated from North Platte in 1952. Jack joined the US Navy and was assigned to the aircraft carrier USS Hancock. After serving in the Navy, Jack attended the University of Nebraska, where he received his Bachelor of Science. Following graduation, Jack started Hansen Agri-PLACEMENT, which has grown to be the leader in national and international agricultural placement.

On August 7, 1964 he was united in marriage to Janice Poore. This union was blessed with 4 children. Jan went home to be with the Lord on Dec. 7, 1987. Jack married Beverly Carmack on May 6, 1995, and gained a son, Roger. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather who was very involved in his children's and grandchildren's lives.
