Jack L. Ross 79, of Doniphan died on Wednesday, March 11, 2026.

Jack was born on October 19, 1946, in Grand Island, the son of Durand and Helen (Shimic) Ross. He was raised in Grand Island graduating from GISH in 1964. While attending GISH, he was a member of the gymnastics team, qualifying for State. He was an avid baseball player throughout his school years. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1966 and was honorably discharged in 1969.

On May 13, 1970, he was united in marriage to Beverly VanBuskirk. This union was blessed with children Demi, Erica and Brady. Jack was employed and retired from Union Pacific Railroad following 30 years of service. He worked at the Doniphan Gun Club for 17 years following his retirement. He spent many years coaching the high school trap team. He had a passion for horses, owning Thoroughbreds and Quarter Horses, and could be found at Fonner Park either helping on the backside or placing bets in the stands. Later in life, he found a love for the outdoors, which included hunting, fishing, golfing and shooting trap. He was an accomplished shooter, winning many awards and accolades.
