Jacqueline "Jackie" Rose Foster, 70, of Grand Island passed away Monday, August 10, 2020, after an over six-year battle with pancreatic cancer.

Jackie was born on January 5, 1950, in Lidgerwood, North Dakota to Fred and Clara Pelvit. She grew up on a farm near Wyndmere, North Dakota and graduated from Wyndmere High School.
